

Watercolor Supply List:

- Watercolor in a tube: (put on your pallet ready for class)
 - Ultramarine Blue
 - Warm Yellow (i.e. Gamboge Yellow)
 - Burnt Sienna
 - Deep Purple
 - Alizarine Crimson (dark cool red)
- Watercolor pallet with plenty of spaces for mixing colors
- Half a sheet of 140 lb Arches Watercolor cold press paper – Tear in half to make 2 – 11 x 15 in. Tear those in half. You should have 4 - 7.5 x 11 in. (Mount 3 of them covering a quarter inch of paper under the masking tape.)
- A scrap piece of watercolor paper to test colors on.
- 3 - 12 x 16 in (heavy cardboard works to mount the watercolor paper on)
- Green painter's tape (to mount the watercolor paper with)
- Holbein spray bottle
- Brushes:
 - 1 - tiny/small round brush (00, or 01, or 1)
 - 1 - med round brush
 - 1 - ½ inch flat brush
 - 1 – 1 inch flat brush
- Salt
- Rag
- Masking fluid
- Masking pen
- Pencil (2H) and eraser
- Natural sponge
- Photos of your favorite waterfall
- Optional- snack, an apron
